### RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A RIVERFRONT DEVELOPMENT AREA FOR THE CITY OF AURORA, INDIANA

Whereas, the City of Aurora, Indiana wishes to expand its current riverfront development area in the City of Aurora, Indiana, and

Whereas, pursuant to Resolution 2004-02 passed by the Common Council for the City of Aurora, Indiana on February 16, 2004, the Department of Transportation committed funds in the form of a TEA grant in the amount of \$500,000.00 to which the City of Aurora has or will contribute \$100,000.00 for streetscaping, lighting, construction of new curbs on Main Street from Judiciary to Third Street which is within the riverfront development area described herein; and

Whereas, pursuant to Resolution 2004-02 passed by the Common Council for the City of Aurora, Indiana on February 16, 2004, the Rising Sun Regional Foundation awarded a grant to the City of Aurora, for \$25,000.00 which has or will be matched by the City of Aurora for replacement of guardrails, road improvements, lighting and sidewalk improvements along Importing Street, Judiciary Street and State Route 56 which is within the riverfront development area described herein; and

Whereas, the municipal riverfront development area is bordered by the Ohio River and the proposed area is within 3 city blocks from the Ohio River.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AURORA, INDIANA as follows:

The City of Aurora, Indiana Riverfront Development area is hereby defined as that area on the map which is attached hereto as "Exhibit A" and is incorporated by reference, and is bounded by the following geographical boundaries:

On the north side, Hogan Creek and U.S. 50 to Importing Street, to the east side of Bridgeway Street; Bridgeway Street to the South side of Fourth Street; from Fourth Street heading east to the Ohio River; then south along Water Street to the intersection of Market Street and State Route 56, also known as Decatur Street, and bordered by the Ohio River on the east side of said area. Then along S.R. 56/Decatur Street adjacent to the Ohio River to the point of beginning. This area encompasses three city blocks from the Ohio River and bordered by the Ohio River, S.R.56 and Decatur Street on the east, Hogan Creek on the north, U.S. 50 and Bridgeway on the west and Fourth Street and Water Street on the south.
